Half (1/2) Point Penalty:
a) Each tick of log, pole cone or obstacle.
One (1) Point Penalty:
a) Each hit of or stepping on log, pole, cone or obstacle.
b) Break gait at walk or trot for two strides or less.
c) Both front or hind feet in a single-strided slot or space at walk or trot.
d) Slipping over or falling to step into required space.
e) Split pole on lope over.
f) Incorrect number of strides, if specified.

Three (3) Point Penalty:
a) Tripsted or break of gait at walk or trot for more than two strides.
b) Out of lead or break of gait at lope.
c) Starting a lope departure at a trot for three (3) strides or more.
d) Knocking down an elevated pole, cone, barrel, plant, obstacle or severely disturbing an obstacle.
e) Fall or jumping off or out of an obstacle with designated boundaries, bridge or water box, with one foot once the horse has gotten onto or into that obstacle.
f) Stepping outside the confines of an obstacle with designated boundaries (i.e., back through, 360 box, side pass) with one foot once the horse has entered the obstacle.
g) Missing or evading pole that is part of a series of an obstacle with one foot.

Five (5) Point Penalty:
a) First and second cumulative refusal, balk or attempting to evade an obstacle. A refusal is addressing an obstacle by taking two (2) or more steps backwards.
b) Letting go of the gate or dropping the rope gate.
c) Use of hand to instill fear.
d) Ground tie - second rein not touching ground.
e) Stepping outside the confines of falling or jumping off or out of an obstacle with more than one foot once the foot has entered the obstacle, including missing one element of an obstacle on a line of travel with two feet.
f) Blatant disobedience (kicking out, bucking, rearing or striking).
g) Failure to demonstrate correct gait between obstacle as designated.
h) Failure to dally on the log drag.

Disqualifications:
a) Use of more than one (1) finger between reins.
b) Use of two (2) hands (except for snaffle bitbackbreaker) except as designated (two hands) or changing hands on reins, except for junior horses for shown with snaffle/bitbackbreaker, only one (1) hand may be used on the reins, except when it is permissible to change hand to work an obstacle.
c) Verbal abuse or any inhumane treatment of horse.
d) Use of ropes other than outlined in the rule book.
e) Performing the obstacle incorrectly or other than in the specified order or no attempt to perform the obstacle.
f) Equipment failures that delay completion of pattern.
g) Fall to the ground by horse or rider.
h) Failure to enter, exit or work obstacle from the correct direction, including more than 1/4 turn.
i) Dropping object required to be carried on course or losing your rope before attempting to rope steer.
j) Failure to follow the correct line of travel between obstacles and/or work obstacles in any manner other than how it's described by the course.
k) Riding outside the designated boundary markers.
l) Third cumulative refusal, balk or evading an obstacle by stying or backing.
m) Gate must be open and closed; failure to leave gate as found will result in disqualification.
n) Failure to dismount to load and unload at the trailer. Horses must remain saddled as they load and unload from the trailer.
o) Letting go of reins when attempting to rope the dummy.

 - One (1) Point Penalty
 - a) Each hit of or stepping on top, pole, cone or obstacle.
 - b) Break gate at walk or trot for two strides or less.
 - c) Both front or hind feet in a single-strided slot or space at walk or trot.
 - d) Slipping over or failing to step into required space.
 - e) Spot pole on loop over.
 - f) Incorrect number of strides if specified.

- Three (3) Point Penalty
- a) Incorrect or break of gait at walk or trot for more than two strides.
 - b) Out of lead or break of gait at lope.
 - c) Starting a lope departure of a trot for three (3) strides or more.
 - d) Knocking down an elevated pole cone, barrel, plant, obstacle or severely disturbing an obstacle.
 - e) Fall or jumping off or out of an obstacle with designated boundaries, bridge or water box, with one foot once the horse has gotten onto or into that obstacle.
 - f) Stepping outside the confines of an obstacle with designated boundaries (i.e.: back through, 360 box, side pass) with one foot once the horse has entered the obstacle.
 - g) Missing or evading pole that is part of a series of an obstacle with one foot.

- Five (5) Point Penalty
- a) First and second cumulative refusal, balk or attempting to evade an obstacle. A refusal is addressing an obstacle by taking two (2) or more steps backwards.
 - b) Letting go of the gait or dropping the rope gate.
 - c) Use of hand to instill fear.
 - d) Ground lie - second rein not touching ground.
 - e) Stepping outside the confines of falling or jumping off or out of an obstacle with designated boundaries with more than one foot once the foot has entered the obstacle, including missing one element of an obstacle on a line of travel with two feet.
 - f) Eminent disobedience (kicking out, bucking, rearing or striking).
 - g) Failure to demonstrate correct gait between obstacle as designated.
 - h) Failure to dally on the log drag.

- Disqualifications
- a) Use of more than one (1) finger between reins.
 - b) Use of two (2) hands (except for snaffle bitback/splint) except as designated (two hand) or changing hands on reins, except for junior horses for whom with snaffle/splint/splint snaffle, only one (1) hand may be used on the reins, except when it is permissible to change hand to work an obstacle.
 - c) Verbal abuse or any inhumane treatment of horse.
 - d) Use of ropet other than outlined in the rule book.
 - e) Performing the obstacle incorrectly or other than in the specified order or no attempt to perform the obstacle.
 - f) Equipment failures that delay completion of pattern.
 - g) Fall to the ground by horse or rider.
 - h) Failure to enter, exit or work obstacle from the correct direction, including more than 1/4 turn.
 - i) Dropping object required to be carried on course or losing your rope before attempting to rope steer.
 - j) Failure to follow the correct line of travel between obstacles and/or work obstacles in any manner other than how it's described by the course.
 - k) Riding outside the designated boundary markers.
 - l) Third cumulative refusal, balk, or evading an obstacle by trying or backing.
 - m) Gate must be open and closed, failure to leave gate as found will result in disqualification.
 - n) Failure to dismount to load and unload at the trailer. Horses must remain saddled as they load and unload from the trailer.
 - o) Letting go of reins when attempting to rope the dummy.
